

The TVT August ride, Sunday August 15th, is at Point Pinole Regional Shoreline so we can enjoy the cool breezes off the San Francisco Bay. We will be riding under the shade of old Eucalyptus trees on both fire roads and single track. This is a wonderful place to bring horses and enjoy rolling hills, walking right into the Bay and over the biggest obstacle I can find, the Amtrak railroad bridge. If Dollar can do it, everyone can! Directions are easy: from Brentwood go straight out hiway 4 to 80 south (toward San Francisco), get off at Richmond Parkway and go towards the Bay Cross San Pablo Avenue and watch for the Pt. Pinole/Giant Highway exit. Turn right at GIANT Hwy. The park entrance will be on the left past the RR tracks. If you are coming from Pleasanton/Livermore/Fremont, go 580 to North on 680 to Hwy 4 then follow the rest of the directions above.

Because the weather is so great, we will ride out at 10:30 allowing everyone time to get to Pinole. See you there.
