Enjoy riding from the secluded base camp at EAGLE MEADOW (6200 ft. elevation). Choose from a variety of trail rides each day. It is advised to start easy to acclimate your horses. The "Long Valley", "Mister's & "Tres Amigos" loops are enjoyable rides along and over creeks and through the forest and meadows for approximately 3 hours. Some 4 to 5 hour favorites include: a visit to the 4000 year old "Bennett Juniper; a great view from "Cowboy Heaven"; a rock climb on the "Niagara Rim" trail; a trip to the Dardanell's Store; and a beautiful ride across Eagle Pass and down into Cooper's Meadow. There will be lots of great camp cooking, a horseshoe tournament, wine & cheese tasting, an auction raffle and bingo. Includes, meals, camping spot, and guided trail rides, must bring your own horse. Located in Tuolumne County, about 1.5 hrs above Sonora CA
