

TVT DAY RIDE  
SATURDAY, November 13  
DIABLO FOOTHILLS

Meet at Macedo Gate--take 680 to Stone Valley Road, go East to Green Valley Road,  
Turn left and go all the way to the parking lot at the end--Macedo Staging area.

Be sure to bring \$6.00 for the parking fee (\$5.00 for seniors over 65).

Arrive at 9:00am  
Be ready to ride out at 10:00am

We will explore the myriad of trails in the Diablo Foothills, stopping for a lunch break (perhaps at the historic Borges Ranch) and return via Briones-Mt Diablo trail/road (possible option would be Castle Rock and Stagecoach Road (Pine Canyon)).

Rain from Thursday onward would cancel the ride. The ride is approximately 10 miles and will be all at a walk, taking about 5 hours, if we stop for lunch. There are some fire roads and many lovely single track trails, including a steep, narrow canyon (Indian Creek trail).

At Macedo Gate there is a big trough for horses to water and a hose to rinse them, too. Also a nice picnic area if you want to stay longer and relax.

Bring halter and lead rope, water, lunch and snacks for yourself on the trail. Dress in layers, it could be cold or windy. The views are spectacular so a camera is advised.
