

TVT DAY RIDE
"DAY OF THE HORSE"
SUNDAY, DECEMBER 12
SUNOL PARK

Let's saddle up the day after the Holiday Party and head to Sunol Park to work off some calories and celebrate the Day of the Horse one day early.

We will do the MaGuire Peaks loop which is about 10miles round trip and should take about 4 hours at a walk, including lunch.

Arrive at 9:30 am

Ride out at 10:30am

Unless you have a parks pass, the fee to enter Sunol with a horse trailer is about \$10.00.

Bring lunch, water, snacks, halter and lead rope. Again the views are spectacular, so bring your camera! Since it is holiday time, you are welcome to dress up a bit in red and/or green (or blue and white).

We can celebrate the Official Day of the Horse a day early and demonstrate to the public that horseback riders have a sense of fun and holiday spirit and are willing to share the trails with other users. If you want, bring a few candy canes to hand out to hikers and bikers!
