Meet at the boat ramp equestrian staging area
BE READY TO RIDE OUT at 10:30am.

There is a \$10.00 fee to enter the park if you do not have a current EBRPD pass. The road to the dam is graveled and good for riding all year. So unless it rains the day of the ride, we should be able to ride out about 4 miles and return by the same route. Bring snacks, water, halter, lead rope, and wear layers of clothing. If it has been raining, be careful and park only on the graveled area on the West side of the parking lot or you might get stuck. If there is a large turnout, we can park on the paved parking lot across the street. Be sure to bring forks to clean up all manure and hay.

There is a nice picnic table at the staging area, water trough and porta-potty. Stay after for a leisurely lunch.

Be sure to contact the trailboss, Marilyn, before 8pm, Thursday, January 14, to let her know you are riding.

Directions:

from the Bay Area (West):

Take 580 toward Stockton,

Take Vasco Road South (there are lots of lights) for about 5 miles. Do not go toward Brentwood!.

Vasco dead ends at Tesla Road. Turn right onto Tesla, go about 3/4 mile and turn left onto Mines Road (there is a stop light at this turn and Mines only goes to the left).

There are signs to the park, but the true Mines road takes off to the left about 5 miles out from Tesla. Stay straight on Del Valle road, which climbs up a long hill. After reaching the top, you go back down to the entry kiosk. It will cost you \$10.00 with the horse trailer, unless you have the EBRPD pass with a horse trailer permit.

Be sure to bring it if you have one! At the kiosk, turn right (toward the boat ramp parking). Continue down the hill until you see the horse trailer parking on the right.
